




Louis Pasteur (1822-1895)



Robert Koch (1843-1910)

- Microbes ‘infect’ a person from outside and cause disease
- Disease is spread by transmission of microbes
- Each microbe has specific disease-causing properties
- Disease is prevented/cured by avoiding or killing microbes, & creating vaccine-induced ‘antibody response’



Antoine Bechamp (1816-1908)


Cellular or Terrain Theory



Claude Bernard (1813-1878)

- Microbes co-exist symbiotically with the body & serve multiple health-preserving & metabolic functions
- Microbes change their function to catabolic & pathogenic **ONLY** when the internal conditions are conducive
- Pathogenic microbes are decomposition agents which proliferate **IN RESPONSE** to a pre-existing disease state
- Disease is prevented & cured by increasing the health of the host organism & maintaining a healthy microbiome






